PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant requests a Conditional Use permit for a travel trailer to be used as a caretaker's residence on an Industrial zoned lot. The applicant currently has a travel trailer on the property (see Attachment A). In the future, the applicant would like to construct an apartment within the existing warehouse and remove the travel trailer.

BACKGROUND

This property is zoned Industrial and currently has a modular home set-up as office space for Wright Services (property owner) and a warehouse which Microcom leases. The applicant for the caretaker's residence is Microcom. The caretaker's residence has been on-site for a few months and was brought to the attention of the Community Development Department through an anonymous complaint. A Building Permit Reminder was issued, resulting in this Conditional Use application.

The applicant requests a caretaker's residence for the site because of set-up and training needs. The travel trailer will be temporary until a more permanent caretaker's unit can be developed within the existing warehouse. Because the applicant intends on constructing a permanent caretaker's unit, staff recommends the following condition:

➤ Prior to a Certificate of Occupancy for another caretaker residence such as the planned apartment within the warehouse, the travel trailer shall be removed from the property.

Staff solicited comments from CDD Building Department, CBJ Streets, General Engineering, CBJ Assessor's Office, Fire Department, and CBJ Public Works, and the following comments were received:

Jay Srader, Chief Building Inspector:

The building code does not regulate DOT designed RV units. If it is to be used as a long term temporary dwelling the Building Department requires cross connection control devices installed on the water connection, an inspection for the electrical hookup, and smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, all done under a valid building permit. The RV cannot be used permanently; there will need to be a removal date identified and possibly removal bond posted per CBJ temporary buildings policy.

Ed Foster, CBJ Streets Superintendent:

Streets Division has no concerns with this request.

Ron King, Chief Regulatory Surveyor:

The caretaker's residence may not be connected to CBJ Water & Sewer utilities.

Dan Jaeger, Fire Marshall:

There does not appear to be any Fire Dept. issues.

Kirk Duncan, CBJ Public Works Director:

It appears to have no issues from Public Works.

Based on the comments received, staff recommends the following conditions and advisory condition:

- 1. The travel trailer shall not be connected to CBJ Water or Sewer facilities.
- 2. The caretaker travel trailer may be replaced in the future in the same location with out additional Planning Commission review. Placement of the travel trailer must be in general conformance with the attached site plan and adhere to building setback requirements.
- 3. Any replacement of the caretaker's unit with another travel trailer or mobile home will require a building permit.

Advisory Condition:

1. A building permit will be required for the caretaker's residence. Please be advised that the Building Department may limit the use of the caretaker's residence for one year with the possibility of an extension, if requested.

ANALYSIS

Project Site – The project site is a 0.41 acre lot with frontage on Jenkins Drive, Anka Street, and Shaune Drive. The access to the caretaker's residence is off of Jenkins Drive. The applicant's long range plan is to construct a permanent caretaker's residence within the existing warehouse.

Project Design – The caretaker's residence is a small travel trailer. The travel trailer will not be hooked up to city water or sanitary services. The current location of the travel trailer meets all zoning setbacks and required parking spaces.

Traffic – The use of the travel trailer as a caretaker's residence will have little impact to traffic. The use functions as a small single-family residence and therefore generates no more traffic than other uses permitted in the Industrial District.

Habitat- There are no habitat concerns with this proposal. There are no anadromous streams, eagles' nests, wetlands, or other sensitive habitat on or near the site.

Parking and Circulation – The two required parking spaces for this use can easily be met. There are no concerns with parking or circulation for this proposed use on this Industrial lot.

Noise – Noise is not expected to be a concern. A caretaker's residence would not have a negative impact to adjacent General Commercial or Industrial lots.

Public Health or Safety – There has been no evidence presented to suggest that a travel trailer being used as a caretaker's residence would negatively impact public health or safety.

Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony – It is not expected that the property value or the neighborhood harmony would be negatively affected should this proposal be approved.

Conformity With Adopted Plans – The caretaker's unit conforms to adopted plans. Specifically, this proposal complies with CBJ §49.65.300(3) and the 2008 CBJ Comprehensive Plan, Development Guideline 10.7.DG2.F.

CBJ §49.65.300

Mobile homes may be located on individual lots outside of mobile home parks or mobile home subdivisions only under the following conditions and after issuance of a building permit:

CBJ §49.65.300(3) The commission may issue a conditional use permit for a single mobile home used as an ordinary residence on an individual lot in the RR, rural reserve district, and the D1 and D3, residential districts, or used as a caretaker residence in any district.

2008 CBJ Comprehensive Plan, Development Guideline 10.7.DG2.F

10.7.DG2 When designating land for heavy and light industrial uses on the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Maps and the Land Use Code zoning maps, evaluate the sites based on the following criteria:

F. Residential uses, *other than caretaker units*, should be discouraged in industrial zones.

FINDINGS

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the Director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete;
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses; and,
- 3. Whether the development as proposed will comply with the other requirements of this chapter.

The Commission shall adopt the Director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the Director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the Commission adopts the Director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (e) & (f), Review of Director's & Commission's Determinations, the Director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

1. Is the application for the requested conditional use permit complete?

Yes. We find the application contains the information necessary to conduct full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conforms to the requirements of CBJ Chapter 49.15.

2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

Yes. The requested permit is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The permit is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section 1.815 for the Industrial zoning district.

3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter. Public notice of this project was provided in the August 12, 2011 and August 19, 2011 issues of the Juneau Empire's "Your Municipality" section, and a Notice of Public Hearing was mailed to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject parcel. Moreover, a Public Notice Sign was posted on the subject parcel, visible from the public Right of Way.

4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

No. As discussed above, there has been no evidence presented to suggest that this proposal will materially endanger the public health or safety.

5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?

No. Based on the analysis in the staff report, this proposal will not substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property n the neighboring area.

6. Will the proposed development be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

Yes. As noted in the preceding staff report, this project conforms with the CBJ Land Use Code and the 2008 CBJ Comprehensive Plan.

Per CBJ §49.70.900 (b)(3), General Provisions, the Director makes the following Juneau Coastal Management Program consistency determination:

7. Will the proposed development comply with the Juneau Coastal Management Program?

Yes. As discussed previously, this project complies with the Juneau Coastal Management Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Planning Commission adopt the Director's analysis and findings and grant the requested Conditional Use permit. The permit would allow the development of a caretaker's residence.

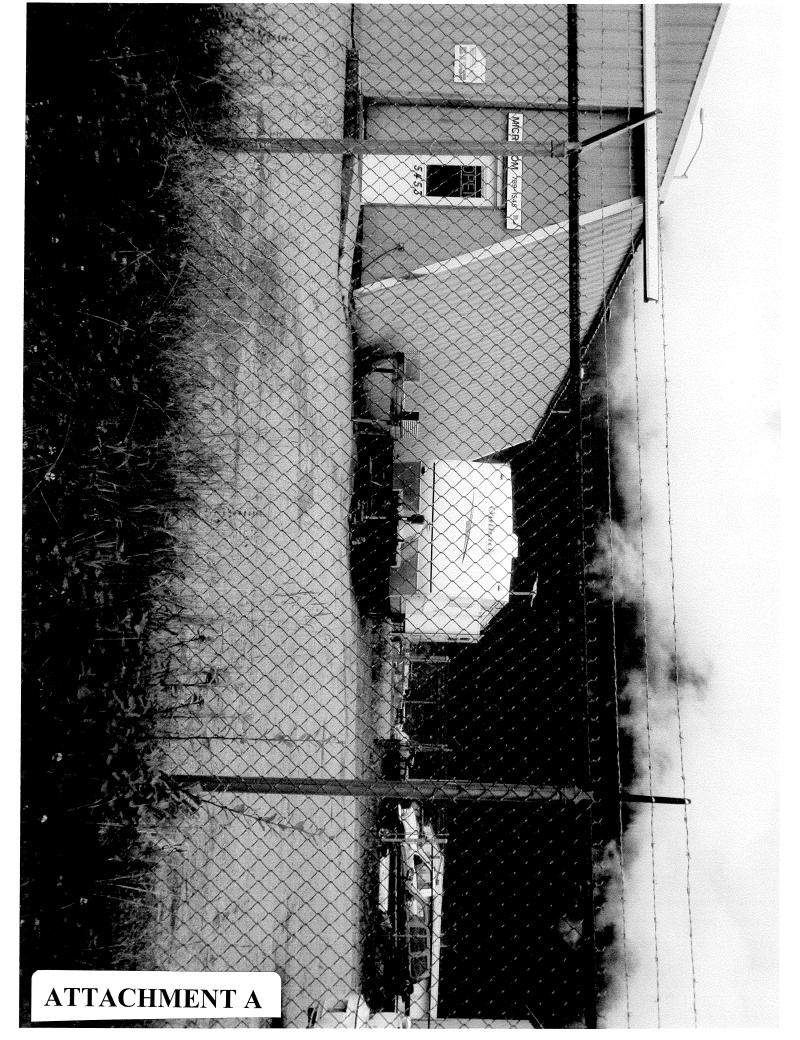
The approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to a Certificate of Occupancy for another caretaker residence such as the planned apartment within the warehouse, the travel trailer shall be removed from the property.
- 2. The travel trailer shall not be connected to CBJ Water or Sewer facilities.
- 3. The caretaker travel trailer may be replaced in the future in the same location with out additional Planning Commission review. Placement of the travel trailer must be in general conformance with the attached site plan and adhere to building setback requirements.
- 4. Any replacement of the caretaker's unit with another travel trailer or mobile home will require a building permit.

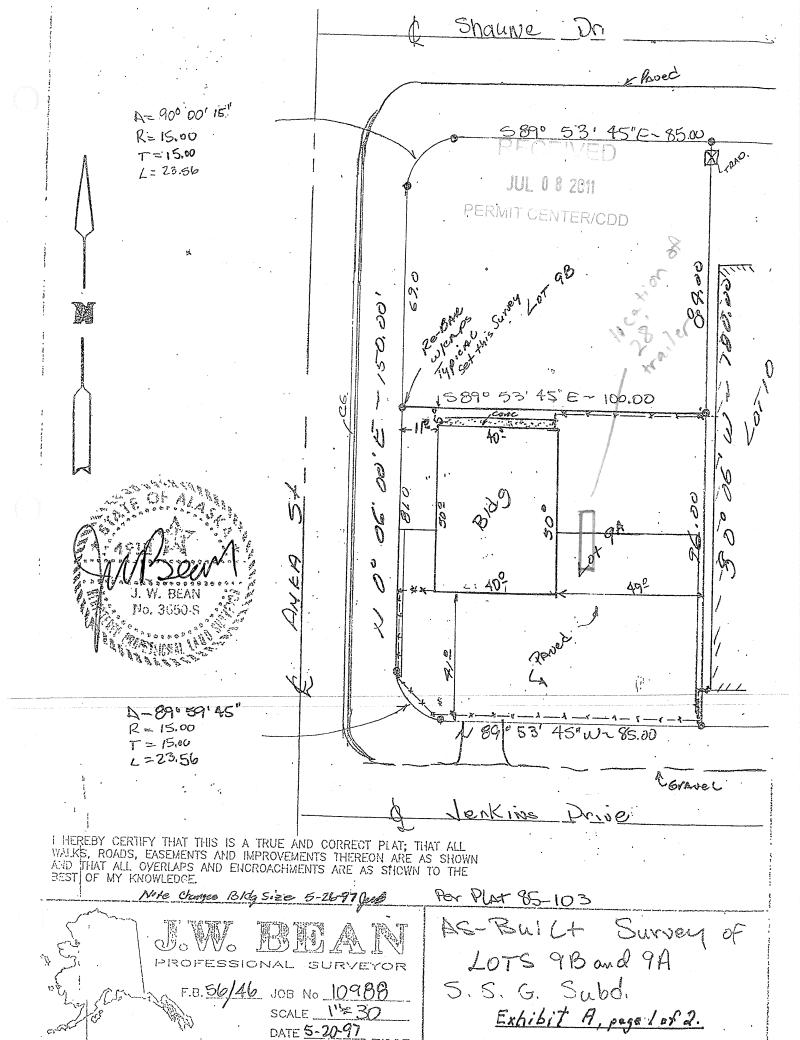

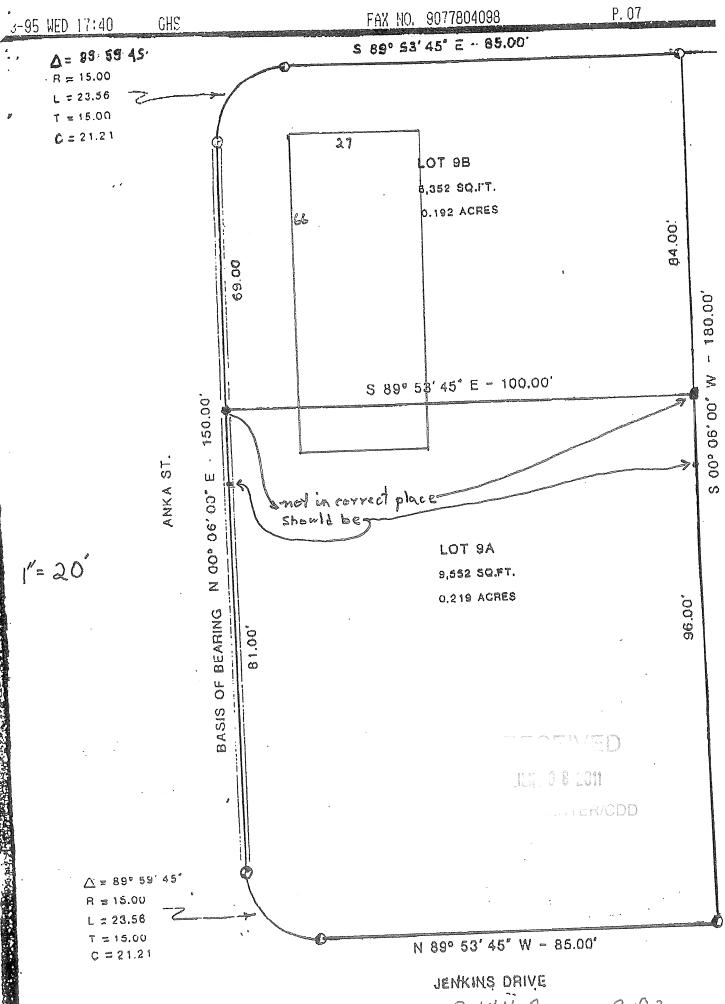
