
Proposed amendment to Title 49 Section 49.75.130 amending the Land

Use Code and the Administrative Appeal Code relating to appeal

Procedures.

Last year the Planning Commission recommended that a proposal to rezone property on Atlin Drive be denied. A property owner in the area suggested that pursuit of the matter to the Assembly should be as an appeal of the Commission's decision, not as a hearing on a recommendation. Although Title 49 is clear that when the Planning Commission approves a rezoning the action is a recommendation, the Code is silent as to whether the action is a recommendation or a final decision if the Commission denies the rezoning. Because only final decisions of the Commission can be appealed to the Assembly, it needs to be clarified if the Commission's action is a recommendation or a final decision. The proposed ordinance would establish that the Commission's decision for denial is a final decision that may be appealed to the Assembly. There may be some minor adjustments to other provisions of Title 49 in the appeals section which should also be approved.

I recommend that the Planning Commission forward to the Assembly a recommendation to approve the proposed Ordinance.

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:
9	Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature
10	and shall become a part of the City and Borough Code.

12	Section 2. Amendment of Section. CBJ 49.75.130 - Procedure, is amended to
13	read:
14	49.75.130 - Procedure.
15	A rezoning shall follow the procedure for a major development permit except for the
16	following:
17	(1) The commission decision for approval shall constitute only a recommendation
18	to the assembly.
19	(2) As soon as possible after the commission's recommendation, the assembly shall
20	provide public notice and hold a public hearing on the proposed rezoning. A
21	rezoning shall be adopted by ordinance, and any conditions thereon shall be
22	contained in the ordinance. Upon adoption of any such ordinance, the director
23	shall cause the official zoning map to be changed in accordance therewith.

(3) The commission decision for denial shall constitute a final agency decision on the matter that may be appealed to the Assembly in accordance with CBJ 49.20.120.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its adoption.
