

This Notice of Decision does not authorize construction. Prior to starting any project, it is the applicant's responsibility to obtain the required building permits.



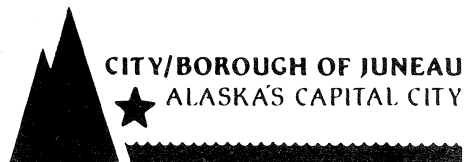
