- 1. Prior to Certificate of Occupancy an As-Built Survey shall be submitted showing the ground floor of the new single family dwelling no closer than 7 feet to the Bradley Street property line and eaves no closer than 4 feet 8 inches feet to the Bradley Street property line and the second and third floors of the new single family dwelling no closer than 10 feet to the Bradley Street property line and eaves no closer than 6 feet 8 inches to the Bradley Street property line. The As-Built Survey shall show that all other setbacks are met as required.
- 2. Prior to approval of the Foundation Setback Verification form a surveyor's statement of compliance shall include that the building's foundation is not closer than 5 feet to the fire hydrant in addition to all other setbacks being met.
