PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant requests a Conditional Use Permit for the development of a 600-square foot apartment on the second floor of a single-family dwelling. A Conditional Use Permit is required because the lot is not served by public sewer, in accordance with CBJ Code 49.25.510(d)(2)(G)(ii).

The lot is currently vacant. Proposed construction of a single-family dwelling is currently under review as BLD2012 0044. The applicant proposes a two-story, two-bedroom home. The accessory apartment would be located on the second floor of the dwelling. The applicant has provided a letter of approval from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) for a septic system that would accommodate a four-bedroom home, so the proposed septic system is twice the size needed for the current use.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Project Site and Design

The site is located in D-1 residential zoning on a vacant waterfront lot adjacent to Tee Harbor, accessible from Cohen Drive. The lot size of 52,272 square feet substantially exceeds the 36,000 square foot minimum lot size for the D-1 zoning district.

The applicant has proposed a two-story, single-family dwelling with one bedroom located on the first floor and a 600 square foot accessory apartment located on the second floor (Attachment 4). The project design meets all other requirements of the Accessory Apartment Ordinance, CBJ Code 49.25.510(D). The applicant has supplied a letter of approval from ADEC regarding a septic system with adequate capacity for a four-bedroom house (Attachment 5). The CBJ Engineering Department has reviewed the proposal and has no comments or concerns.

Traffic, Parking, and Circulation -

The proposed development meets all parking requirements.

Noise -

The proposed development will not generate significant noise. The lot meets all density requirements to accommodate an accessory apartment.

Public Health or Safety -

ADEC has approved the proposed septic system for the development, which has capacity to support a four-bedroom home. The proposed development has only two bedrooms, including the accessory apartment. Therefore public health and safety concerns from a private septic system have been addressed. Staff is unaware of any other public health or safety issues associated with the development.

Habitat –

There are no habitat issues associated with this development.

Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony -

No evidence indicates that the proposed development will have a negative impact on property value or neighborhood harmony. The development meets all requirements for accessory apartments, and the 52,272 square foot lot is substantially larger than the 36,000 square foot minimum lot size in the D-1 zoning district.

Conformity with Adopted Plans -

The project substantially conforms with the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan Policy 4.1 as follows:

Policy 4.1 It is the policy of the CBJ to facilitate the provision and maintenance of safe, sanitary and affordable housing for its residents.

The proposed development meets the intent of this policy by providing an accessory apartment on a lot with an approved private septic system.

FINDINGS

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the Director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete;
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses; and,
- 3. Whether the development as proposed will comply with the other requirements of this chapter.

The Commission shall adopt the Director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the Director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the Commission adopts the Director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more, probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (e) & (f), Review of Director's & Commission's Determinations, the Director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

1. Is the application for the requested conditional use permit complete?

Yes. We find the application contains the information necessary to conduct full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conforms to the requirements of CBJ Chapter 49.15.

2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

Yes. The requested permit is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The permit is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section 1.130 for the D-1 zoning district.

3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter. Public notice of this project was provided in the August 31, 2012 and September 7, 2012 issues of the Juneau Empire's "Your Municipality" section, and a Notice of Public Hearing was mailed to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject parcel. Moreover, a Public Notice Sign was posted on the subject parcel, visible from the public Right of Way.

4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

No. As described in the preceding analysis, no evidence indicates that the proposed development will materially endanger the public health or safety. The proposed septic system has been approved by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.

- 5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?
- **No.** As described in the preceding analysis, no evidence indicates that the development will substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area.
- 6. Will the proposed development be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

Yes. The proposed development meets the intent of the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan, specifically Policy 4.1 regarding provision of affordable housing.


Per CBJ §49.70.900 (b)(3), General Provisions, the Director makes the following Juneau Coastal Management Program consistency determination:

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission adopt the Director's analysis and findings and grant the requested Conditional Use permit. The permit would allow the development of a 600 square foot accessory apartment on the second floor of a single family dwelling on a lot that is not served by public sewer.

Allowable/Conditional Use Permit Application Instructions

<u>Pre-Application Conference</u>: A pre-application conference is required prior to submitting an application. The applicant will meet with City & Borough of Juneau and Agency staff to discuss the proposed development, the permit procedure and to determine the application fees. To schedule a pre-application conference, please contact the Permit Center at 586-0770 or via e-mail at <u>Permits@ci.juneau.ak.us</u>.

<u>Application</u>: An application for an Allowable/Conditional Use Permit will not be accepted by the Community Development Department until it is determined to be complete. The items needed for a complete application are:

Forms: A completed Allowable/Conditional Use Permit Application and Development Permit Application form. The "land owner or lessee consent" signature <u>and</u> initials are <u>mandatory</u> on the Development Permit Application form.

Fees: The fee is dependent upon the class of the proposed use. Land Use fees generally range from \$300 to \$1,350. Any development, work or use done without a permit issued will be subject to double fees. All fees are subject to change.

Project Description: A detailed letter or narrative describing the project.

Plans: All plans are to be drawn to scale and clearly show the items listed below:

- A. Site plan, floor plan and elevation views of existing and proposed structures
- B. Existing and proposed parking areas, including dimensions of the spaces, aisle width and driveway entrances
- C. Proposed traffic circulation within the site including access/egress points and traffic control devices
- D. Existing and proposed lighting (including cut sheets for each type of lighting)
- E. Existing and proposed vegetation with location, area, height and type of plantings
- F. Existing physical features of the site (i.e. drainage, eagle trees, hazard areas, salmon streams, wetlands, etc.)

Document Format: All information that is submitted as part of an application shall be submitted in either of the following formats:

- A. Electronic copies may be submitted by CD, DVD or E-mail in the following formats: .doc, .txt, .xls, .bmp, .pdf, .jpg, .gif .xlm, .rtf or other formats pre-approved by the Community Development Department.
- B. Paper copies may not be larger than 11" X 17" (Unless a larger paper size is preapproved by the Community Development Department).

<u>Application Review & Hearing Procedure</u>: Once the application is determined to be complete, the Community Development Department will initiate the review and scheduling of the application. This process includes:


Review: As part of the review process the Community Development Department will evaluate the application for consistency with all applicable City & Borough of Juneau codes and adopted plans. Depending on unique characteristics of the permit request the application may be required to be reviewed by other municipal boards and committees. During this review period, the Community Development Department also sends all applications out for a 15-day agency review period. Review comments may require the applicant to provide additional information, clarification, or submit modifications/alterations for the proposed project.

Hearing: All Allowable/Conditional Use Permit Applications must be reviewed by the Planning Commission. Once an application has been deemed complete and has been reviewed by all applicable parties the Community Development Department will schedule the requested permit for the next appropriate meeting.

<u>Public Notice Responsibilities</u>: As part of the Allowable/Conditional Use permitting process, all permit requests must be given proper public notice, which consists of the following:

Community Development Department: Will give notice of the pending Planning Commission meeting and its agenda in the local newspaper a minimum of 10-days prior to the meeting. Furthermore, the department will mail abutters notices to all property owners within 500-feet of the project site.


Applicant: Will post a sign on the site at least 14-days prior to the meeting. The sign shall be visible from a public right-of-way or where determined to be appropriate by the Department. Signs may be produced by the Community Development Department for a preparation fee of \$50, and a \$100 deposit that will be refunded in full if the sign is returned by 4:30 p.m. on the Monday following the scheduled hearing date. If the sign is returned later than the Monday after the Planning Commission meeting, but within two weeks of the meeting, \$50.00 may be refunded. The applicant may make and erect their own sign. Please speak with the Community Development Department for more information.




CONSTELLATION DEVELOPMENT

Dear Mr. Arndt:

The department has reviewed the engineering plans submitted for the referenced project. Approval is hereby given to construct the proposed engineered system on the referenced property. The system consists of a 600 GPD Bluewater NSF approved secondary treatment plant, and a 450 square foot sand-lined drainfield, as per the latest plans submitted to ADEC, and supplemental emails. The system serves a four (4) bedroom house with an estimated maximum wastewater generation of 600 gallons per day.

Advisories and Recommendations:

- 1. This construction approval is valid for two years. If the project is not constructed within two years, new plans and associated fees must be submitted to ADEC for review and approval.
- 2. This approval is contingent upon compliance with the conditions of Wastewater Disposal Regulations, 18 AAC 72.235, Construction Certification. The noted section of the regulations requires that a "Certification of Construction" be completed and submitted to the Department within ninety (90) days of completion of construction. Record drawings, submitted by your engineer, must indicate any changes or deviations from the approved plans to facilitate final review. A "Certification of Construction" form is enclosed for your use.
- 3. This approval is contingent upon your receipt of any other state, federal or local authorizations which are required for your project. You are required to obtain all other necessary authorizations before proceeding with your project.
- 4. You are advised that if this development will require placing fill in wetlands or working in a stream, river, or lake, permits from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Alaska Department of Fish and Game may be required. A Coastal Projects Questionnaire will help you identify other permits and approvals that may be required for your project.

Any person who disagrees with this decision may request an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195 – 18 AAC 15.340 or an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185.

Informal review requests must be delivered to the Division Director, 555 Cordova Street, Anchorage, Alaska 99501, within 15 days of receipt of the plan review decision. Adjudicatory hearing requests must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99801, within 30 days of the decision. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
