SUBJECT: Continuance of USE2012 0016—Indoor Shooting Range

The Conditional Use Permit application (USE2012 0016) for the Indoor Shooting range proposed to be located on the corner of Crest Street and Yandukin Drive is postponed until further notice.

During the review process it was identified that the project as proposed does not meet City and Borough of Juneau's ordinance CBJ §42.50.020(a)(1-2):

(a) It is unlawful for any person except a peace officer in the line of duty, to fire or discharge any firearm within one-quarter mile of any public street, road or highway within the City and Borough of Juneau, except that it is not unlawful to discharge:

(1) a shotgun within the Mendenhall Wetlands State Game Refuge,

or

(2) a firearm at a shooting range operated by the Hank Harmon Memorial Rifle Range, the Juneau Gun Club, or the federal or state government.
