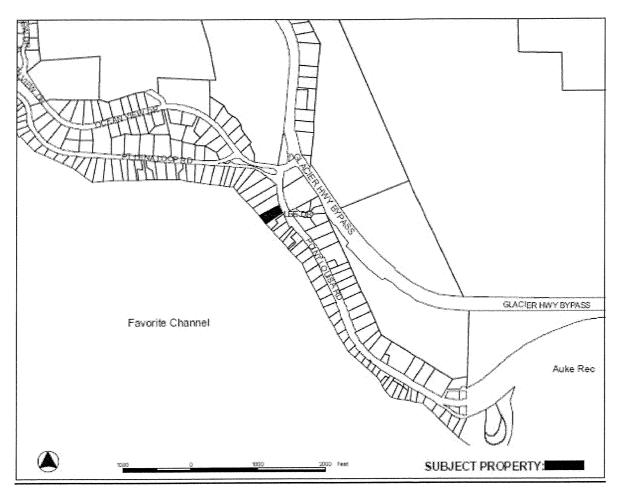

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The applicant requests a Conditional Use permit for the development of a 400 square foot accessory apartment attached to a proposed detached garage. A Conditional Use Permit is required because the lot is not served by public sewer, in accordance with the City and Borough of Juneau's Land Use Code, CBJ 49.25.510(d)(2)(G)(ii).

The lot currently has a two story single-family home with a detached garage under construction. The applicant has provided a letter of approval from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC). The letter verifies that the proposed apartment will be sufficiently served by the existing on-site waste water disposal system.

#### **ANALYSIS**

**Project Site and Design** – The site is located in a D-3 residential zoning district on a waterfront lot next to Stephens Passage accessible by off of Point Louisa Road. The lot size is 43,995 square feet which far exceeds the 12,000 square foot minimum lot size for the D-3 zoning district.

The applicant has proposed a 400 square foot accessory apartment (Attachment D). The project meets all other requirements of the Accessory Apartment Ordinance, in the City and Borough of Juneau's Land Use Code, CBJ 49.25.510(d)(2). The applicant has supplied a letter of approval from ADEC regarding approval of the on-site waste water disposal system and its capacity to serve the home and the proposed accessory apartment (Attachment C).

**Traffic, Parking, and Circulation** – The parking requirements for this property are three parking spaces; two for the single-family home and one for the accessory apartment. The proposed project has adequate space for parking and meets the parking requirements for a single-family home and accessory apartment. The property is served by Point Louisa Road. Please see Attachment D for photos of existing site.

**Noise** - The proposed development will not generate significant noise. The lot meets density requirements to accommodate an accessory apartment.

**Public Health or Safety** – ADEC has approved the existing on-site septic system for capability of serving the existing home and the proposed accessory apartment. Public health and safety concerns for the private waste water disposal system have been addressed. Staff is unaware of any other public health or safety issues associated with the proposed development.

**Habitat** - There are no habitat issues associated with this development.

**Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony -** No available evidence indicates that the proposed development will have a negative impact on property value or neighborhood harmony. The development meets all requirements for accessory apartments, and the 43,995 square foot lot is larger than the 12,000 square foot minimum lot size in the D-3 zoning district.

**Conformity with Adopted Plans -** The project substantially conforms with the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan Policy 4.1 as follows:

Policy 4.1. It is the policy of the CBJ to facilitate the provision and maintenance of safe, sanitary, and affordable housing for its residents.

The proposed development meets the intent of this policy by providing an accessory apartment on a lot not served by public sewer.

#### **FINDINGS**

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the Director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete;
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses; and,
- 3. Whether the development as proposed will comply with the other requirements of this chapter.

The Commission shall adopt the Director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the Director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the Commission adopts the Director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (e) & (f), Review of Director's & Commission's Determinations, the Director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

#### 1. Is the application for the requested conditional use permit complete?

**Yes.** We find the application contains the information necessary to conduct full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conforms to the requirements of CBJ Chapter 49.15.

#### 2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

**Yes.** The requested permit is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The permit is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section 1.130 for the D-3 zoning district.

#### 3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter. Public notice of this project was provided in the April 12, 2013 and April 22, 2013 issues of the Juneau Empire's "Your Municipality" section, and a Notice of Public Hearing was mailed to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject parcel. Moreover, a Public Notice Sign was posted on the subject parcel, visible from the public Right of Way.

#### 4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

**No.** As described in the preceding analysis, available evidence indicates that the proposed development will not endanger the public health or safety. The existing on-site waste water disposal system has been approved by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation to adequately support the existing home and the proposed accessory apartment.

5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?

**No.** As described in the preceding analysis, no available evidence indicates that the development will substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with the property in the neighboring area.

6. Will the proposed development be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

**Yes.** The proposed development meets the intent of the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan, specifically Policy 4.1. regarding provision of affordable housing.

Per CBJ §49.70.900 (b)(3), General Provisions, the Director makes the following Juneau Coastal Management Program consistency determination:

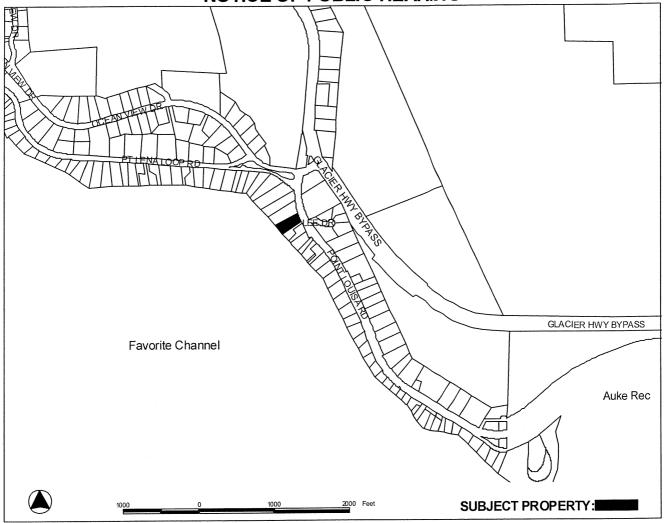
7. Will the proposed development comply with the Juneau Coastal Management Program?

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Planning Commission adopt the Director's analysis and findings and grant the requested Conditional Use permit. The permit would allow the development of a 400 square foot accessory apartment to be adjacent to a detached garage, on a lot that is not served by public sewer.

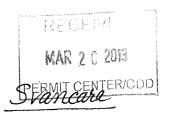
