The Board of Adjustment, at its regular public meeting, adopted the analysis and based on additional information provided at the hearing, modified criterion 1 as shown below:

1. Granting this variance would provide relief to the property owner and would allow the remodeling of the existing building to provide a larger living space while also providing a single car garage. This relaxation is consistent with justice to other property owners in that it meets the intent of the setbacks.

The Commission approved the Variance to be conducted as described in the project description and project drawings submitted with the application and with the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall submit a plan for decommissioning the existing driveway on to Mendenhall Loop Road approved by CDD staff prior to issuance of a building permit for the garage.
- 2. Prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy or Temporary Certificate of Occupancy, for the dwelling, the driveway accessing Mendenhall Loop Road must be removed.
