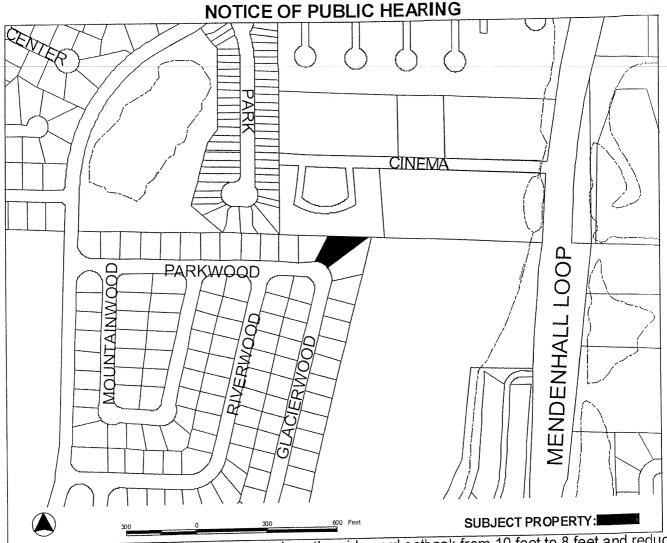

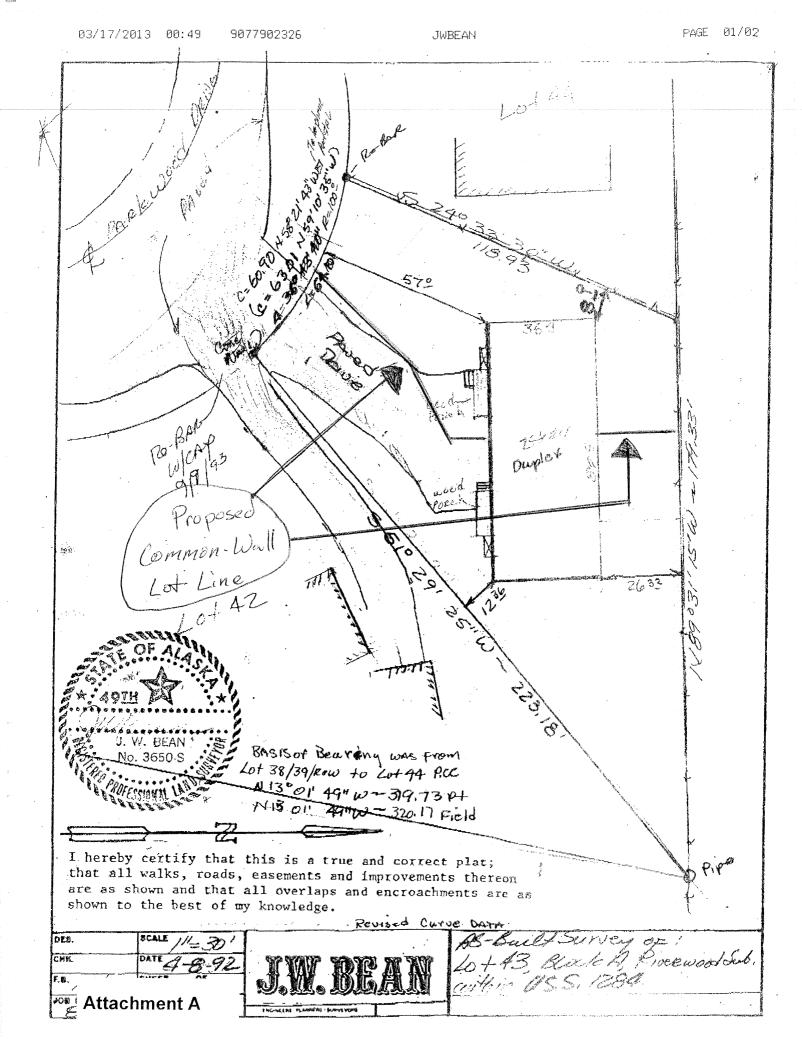

Eric,

5. A. This site is more than large enough for ZLL and all other requirements can be met. The site is unique because it is located on a curve in the road and this has the effect of making lot frontage narrower that it otherwise would be and narrower than that of other lots in the neighborhood.

B. The configuration of the site, located on a curve and platted without enough original width but with plenty of overall area, unreasonably prevents owner from converting this duplex to a pair of Zero lot line homes.

- c. As said above, there is a unique physical feature of the lot on a curve in the roadway and awkward platting that makes compliance with zoning standards outright impossible without variance.
- 6. The benefit enables the availability of two relatively low cost single family homes into a very restricted residential market. The neighborhood will benefit from occupancy by owner families. No detriments can be sited. AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

Soapy,

I am nearly done writing the staff report for your variance. Two of the six variance findings have not been met and our department will not recommend in support of the variance unless you believe that these two findings can be met. The two findings are shown below.

5. That compliance with the existing standards would:

- Unreasonably prevent the owner from using the property for a permissible principal (A)
- Unreasonably prevent the owner from using the property in a manner which is (B)consistent as to scale, amenities, appearance or features, with existing development in the neighborhood of the subject property;
- (C) Be unnecessarily burdensome because unique physical features of the property render compliance with the standards unreasonably expensive;

or

- Because of preexisting nonconforming conditions on the subject parcel the grant of the (D) Variance would not result in a net decrease in overall compliance with the Land Use Code, CBJ Title 49, or the building code, CBJ Title 19, or both.
- 6. That a grant of the Variance would result in more benefits than detriments to the neighborhood.

5.

A. Common wall development is a permissible use within D-5 zoning district, not allowing for variations within dimensional standards in situations that would not create any impacts would be unreasonable restriction on private development rights.

B. Per the previous statement, denial of this variance would unreasonably prevent owner from subdividing this parcel in a manner which would be consistent with scale, amenities, appearance and existing pattern of the neighborhood.

C. Due to the geometry of the subject parcel, compliance with the standards is not achievable without a variance. While this lot has more than enough area, and setbacks could be met if it was not cost prohibitive, it does not have adequate width to accommodate a common wall sub without a variance.

There is already a legally conforming two unit structure occupying this space, it is hard to imagine any potential impacts that would develop as a result of a change in land ownership.
