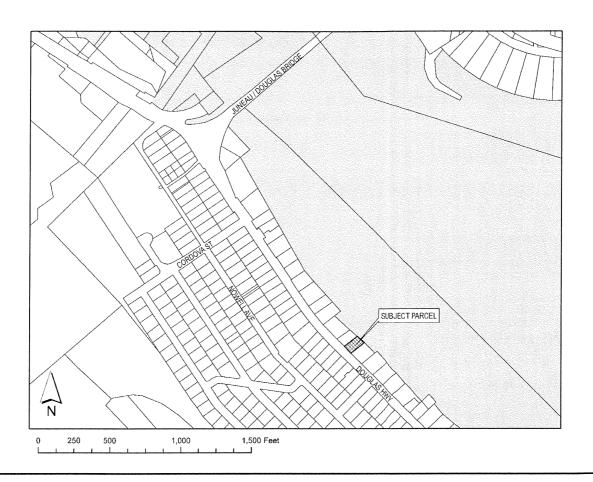

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant requests a Conditional Use permit for the operation of a five bedroom bed and breakfast. There is an accessory apartment that functions as the owner's residence for the bed and breakfast.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The previous owners of the Beachside Villa Bed and Breakfast received a Conditional Use permit (USE1998 00048) in 1999 to operate a three bedroom bed and breakfast. The permit expired with the transfer of ownership in 2004 per condition #2 of the permit (see Attachment A). The current owner was unaware of the expiration or need for a conditional use permit until approaching the permitting center on a separate matter. She is now seeking a Conditional Use permit to continue operation of the bed and breakfast.

#### **ANALYSIS**

**Project Site** – CBJ § 49.80.120 defines a bed and breakfast as, "a dwelling in which more than two bedrooms are used for commercial lodging provided by the owner or operator who lives on site". The site is located in a D5 zoning district approximately 1/3 of a mile south of the Douglas Bridge. The residence at 3120 Douglas Highway is a 3,824 square foot home on a 7,000 square foot parcel. The lot is bordered on both the north and south by single family residences, on the east by Gastineau Channel and the west by Douglas Highway and single family residences. According to CBJ § 49.25.300 *Table of Permissible Uses* bed and breakfasts are allowed in the D5 zoning district with a Conditional Use permit.

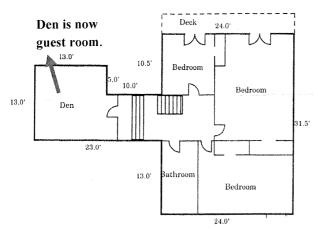


Figure 2: Top floor with four guest rooms

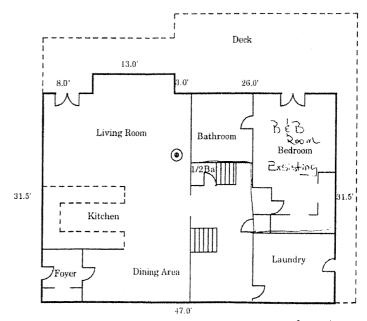


Figure 3: Second story with common area and guest room

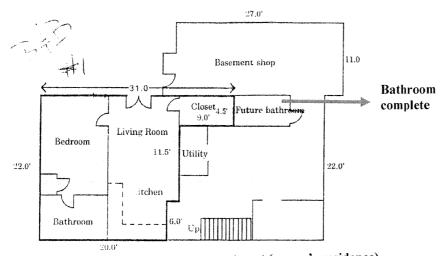


Figure 4: Basement with accessory apartment (owner's residence)

**Project Design** – According to the applicant, no changes have been made to the interior or exterior of the residence since the transfer of ownership in 2004. The applicant purchased the residence to continue the operation of the bed and breakfast established by the previous owners. When the original Conditional Use permit was issued, the structure was a four-bedroom house with an accessory apartment. According to the applicant, the previous owner converted the "den" into another guest bedroom on an indeterminable date. There are now four bedrooms on the top floor and one on the second floor for guest rental (see Figures 2 and 3). The owner resides in the accessory apartment located in the basement (see Figure 4).

**Traffic** – This bed and breakfast has been in operation since 1999. There is no evidence that the business has caused traffic problems. According to the Alaska Department of Transportation's 2011 Southeast Region Traffic Maps, the section of road where this bed and breakfast is located on Douglas Highway has approximately 8,076 trips per day. This number increases by more than 4,000 along the 1/3 mile between the site and the Juneau-Douglas Bridge. The addition of guests coming to or from the bed and breakfast that may or may not travel with a vehicle has minimal impact on the overall daily traffic.

**Parking and Circulation** – The parking requirement for a bed and breakfast is one space per two bedrooms and one space for an accessory apartment (CBJ § 49.20.210). A total of 4 parking spaces is the requirement for this development. The site has two parking pads that can accommodate five standard vehicles based on the parking space requirements in CBJ § 49.40.210(b)(1) which require a parking space to at least 8.5 feet wide and 17 feet long. According to the Alaska Department of Transportation driveway permit, issued on March 3, 1995, backing into the driveway is required so that vehicles can leave the site without backing onto Douglas Highway (see Attachment C).

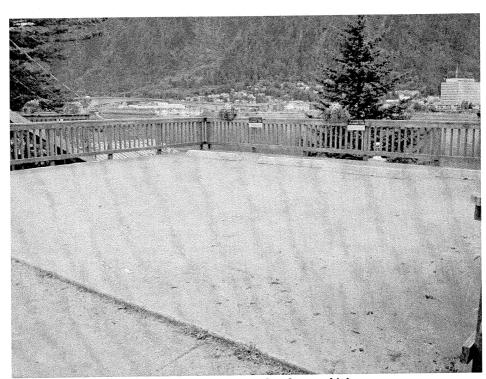


Figure 5: Parking pad for three vehicles

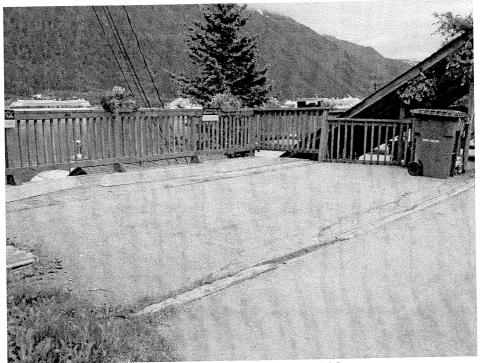


Figure 6: Parking Pad for two vehicles

**Noise** – Noise is not expected to be a concern with the continued operation of the bed and breakfast. Notice of the Conditional Use permit request was issued to the neighboring properties and at the time of the writing of the staff report no comments were received.

**Public Health or Safety** – There is no evidence to suggest that the proposed operation would endanger public health or safety. The bed and breakfast has been in operation for many years without incident.

**Habitat** – Not applicable. The bed and breakfast has been established for over 14 years and is in a dense residential neighborhood. This permit is needed to continue the operation of a pre-existing bed and breakfast and no additional structures are being built that would affect wetlands or eagles' nests or anadromous streams.

**Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony** – The surrounding area is primarily single family residential and accessory apartments. There are also apartment complexes in the vicinity. The previous review of the bed and breakfast expected no effect on property values.

**Conformity with Adopted Plans** – Issuance of a Conditional Use permit for a five bedroom bed and breakfast is allowable based on CBJ §49.25.300 *Table of Permissible Uses*. The Comprehensive Plan identifies the need to promote independent and over-night travelers and promote "development that supports year-round visitor services and activities". Further, Policy 5.4 in the Comprehensive Plan states:

"It is the policy of the CBJ to encourage tourism, convention and other visitor-related activities through the development of appropriate facilities and services, while protecting Juneau's natural,

cultural and economic attractions for local residents and visitors alike, and to participate in the accommodation of the future growth of tourism in a manner that addresses both community and industry concerns."

A small locally owned and operated bed and breakfast fits in with this vision set forth in the Comprehensive Plan.

#### **FINDINGS**

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the Director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete;
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses; and,
- 3. Whether the development as proposed will comply with the other requirements of this chapter.

The Commission shall adopt the Director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the Director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the Commission adopts the Director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (e) & (f), Review of Director's & Commission's Determinations, the Director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

## 1. Is the application for the requested conditional use permit complete?

**Yes.** We find the application contains the information necessary to conduct full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conforms to the requirements of CBJ Chapter 49.15.

## 2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

**Yes.** The requested permit is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The permit is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section1.610 for the D5 zoning district.

## 3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter. Public notice of this project was provided in the July 13 and July 22, 2013 issues of the Juneau Empire's "Your Municipality" section, and a Notice of Public Hearing was mailed to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject parcel. Moreover, a Public Notice Sign was posted on the subject parcel, visible from the public Right of Way.

## 4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

No. Based on the preceding staff analysis, no evidence is found to indicate that the proposed use will materially endanger the public health or safety.

5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?

**No.** Based on the preceding staff analysis, no evidence is found to indicate that the proposed use will substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area.

6. Will the proposed development be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

**Yes.** Based on the preceding staff analysis, it is found that the proposed development is in general conformity with the Comprehensive Plan of the City and Borough of Juneau.

Per CBJ §49.70.900 (b)(3), General Provisions, the Director makes the following Juneau Coastal Management Program consistency determination:

7. Will the proposed development comply with the Juneau Coastal Management Program?

Not applicable.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Planning Commission adopt the Director's analysis and findings and grant the requested Conditional Use permit. The permit would allow the continued operation of a five guestroom bed and breakfast in the residence at 3120 Douglas Highway.

PERMIT CENTERIOD

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant requests a conditional use permit for the operation of a three-room bed and breakfast. The approval of this request will allow for expansion of the existing bed and breakfast. The maximum occupancy will be five guests. The applicant proposes to operate with more than three guests six months of the year. The site offers five off-street parking spaces.

#### **ANALYSIS**

The site is located in a D-5 zoning district. The CBJ Land Use Code designates a bed and breakfast operation as a rooming or boarding house. If lodging is to be provided to more than three persons in a D-5 zone, then a conditional use permit is required. The applicant intends to exceed the three-person limit and thus needs a conditional use permit.

**Project Design -** The applicant intends to utilize three bedrooms within the residence. No exterior changes are anticipated at this time.

**Parking and Circulation -** The parking requirement for the operation and residence is four spaces. The bed and breakfast operation is required to provide two spaces and the residential use requires two spaces. The applicant has constructed parking decks to accommodate the parking requirement.

A copy of the State of Alaska, DOTPF, Driveway Permit #1328, has been submitted with the application. A condition of that permit states that backing out onto Douglas Highway is not permitted from this site.

**Signs -** A separate permit process per CBJ §49.45, Signs, requires that all signs proposed by the development be submitted to CDD staff for review and approval.

**Public Health or Safety -** CDD has been incorporating the courtesy inspection provided by the Building Division into B&B permit review to ensure that these dwellings meet minimum life/safety standards established by the CBJ Building Code.

**Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony -** The current uses in this area are single-family and accessory apartment residential. A three-person B&B operates at 3260 Douglas Highway. A CBJ Appraiser, Tom Pitts, has commented that he has no evidence to indicate that the presence of a bed and breakfast in a neighborhood has affected property values.

**Conformity With Adopted Plans -** The development, as proposed, is residential and properly located in a D-5 zoning district. The development conforms with other adopted plans including the CBJ Comprehensive Plan.

**Juneau Coastal Management Program -** We find that no provisions of the JCMP apply to this request.

#### **FINDINGS**

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete; and,
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses;

The commission shall adopt the director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the commission adopts the director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.300 (e)(1)(A thru C), Review of Director's Determinations, the director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

#### 1. Is the application for the requested conditional use permit complete?

Yes. We find the application contains the information necessary to conduct a full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conform to the requirements of CBJ code Chapters 49.15.

## 2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

**Yes.** The proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The use is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section 1.610 for the D-5 zone.

## 3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (d)(5)(A thru C), Director's Review Procedure, the director makes the following additional findings:

## 4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

**No.** Based on the preceding staff analysis, no evidence is found to indicate that the proposed development will materially endanger the public health or safety. These concerns are primarily addressed by the State driveway permit and the building inspection required by condition of this permit.

# 5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?

**No.** Based on the preceding staff analysis, no evidence is found to indicate that the proposed development will substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area. Based on the comment from a CBJ Appraiser, the development is anticipated to have no effect on property values. Another bed and breakfast is present and operating harmoniously in the neighborhood.

# 6. Will the proposed development not be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

Yes. Based on the preceding staff analysis, it is found that the proposed development is properly sited and in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, and the comprehensive plan.

## 7. Will the proposed development comply with the Juneau Coastal Management Program?

**Not Applicable.** No provisions of the Juneau Coastal Management Program apply to the proposed development.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

We recommend that the Planning Commission adopt the director's findings and grant the requested conditional use permit. The permit would allow the operation of a five-person bed and breakfast within the existing dwelling at 3120 Douglas Highway. The operator may provide lodging to more than three persons six months of the year. The approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall request, within 21 days of the effective day of this permit, a Courtesy Inspection of the dwelling from the Community Development Department to identify any major health or safety issues that may exist. If such issues are identified, the applicant shall conform to the requirements as specified by the CBJ Building Official.
- 2. The permit shall expire when property ownership transfers from the current owner(s) to another owner(s).

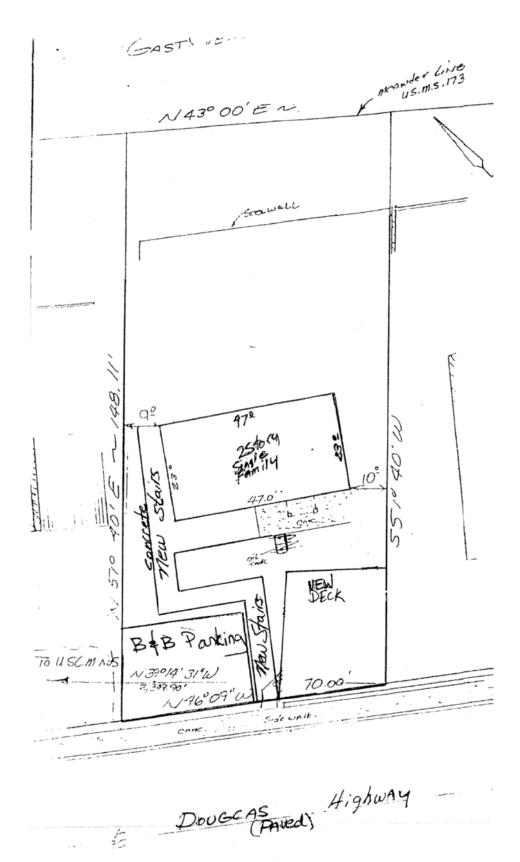

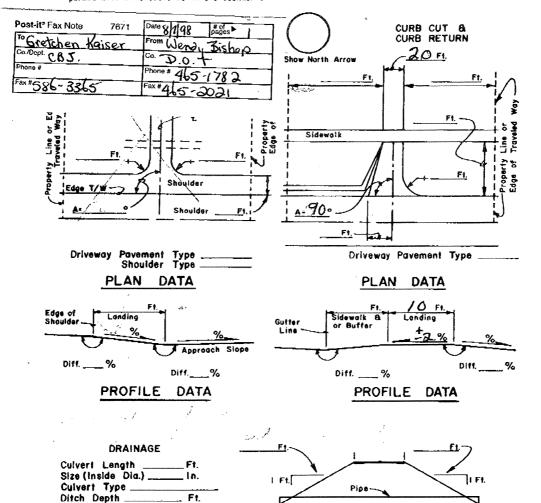
