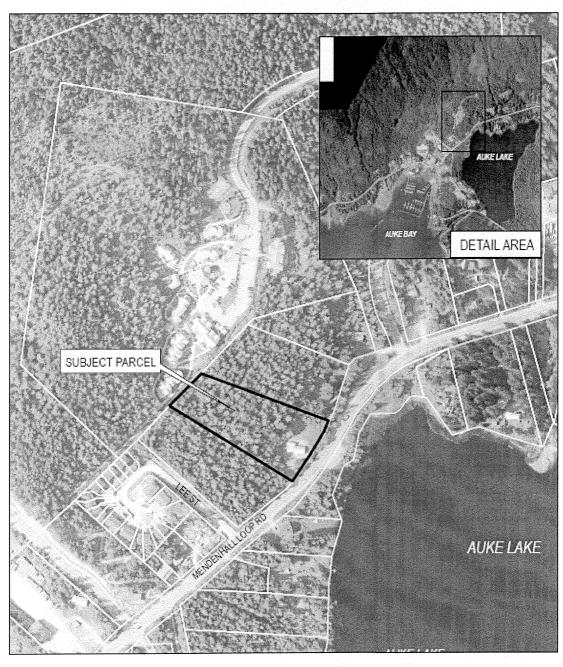

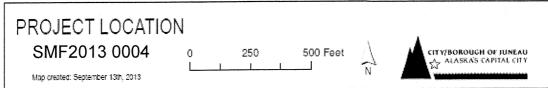

PROPOSAL

A Final Plat approval of Auke Lake Ridge subdivision of six new lots, located along Back Loop Road across from Auke Lake. This subdivision case is the second phase. The first phase (Preliminary Plat Approval) was completed in February 2013. A draft subdivision plat, as-built survey, and a Homeowners Association agreement have been submitted for this Final plat, under Attachments A-C respectively.

Since the approval of the preliminary subdivision permit, the applicant has prepped the land with a new driveway which will be shared by all six lots, installed utilities, and drainages.

BACKGROUND

In January 2013, the Planning Commission approved a variance permit (case # VAR2012 0029) to allow four of the six lots of the subdivision to be smaller than the minimum lot depth. The following month, the Commission approved a Preliminary Major Subdivision permit (case # SMP2012 0002) for the subdivision which allowed the applicant to prep the land with new utilities and extend the driveway. The Variance and Preliminary Plat permits were approved with conditions, as listed below.

VAR2012 0029 Variance Permit Conditions:

- 1. The subdivision plat shall include a note requiring that all lots be accessed with a single, shared driveway only and that vehicular access to Mendenhall Loop Road from the individual lots will not be allowed. Completed see Attachments A & B.
- 2. Prior to final plat recording, the developer shall provide for a homeowner's association whose responsibility will be to ensure that the property owners will provide for the continued maintenance of the shared driveway. **Completed see Attachment C.**
- 3. Documents creating the homeowner's association shall be recorded concurrently with the final plat. **Pending Final Plat approval.**

4. Fire apparatus access and turn-around must be provided and shall be constructed to International Fire Code Standards prior to issuance of any Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO) or Certificate of Occupancy (CO) for dwellings on the property. Completed - Capital City Fire & Rescue (CCF/R) has accepted the constructed shared driveway.

SMP2012 0002 Preliminary Plat permit conditions:

- 1. Add new plat note stating "Parts of this subdivision may contain wetlands. Consultation with appropriate regulatory agencies is required prior to filling wetlands." Complete See Attachment A.
- 2. Prior to Final Plat approval, the applicant shall designate all wetlands on the plat derived from a wetland delineation. As with other sensitive environments, i.e. streamside setbacks, avalanche paths, wetlands are not delineated on plats but rather are addressed as plat notes. Wetland delineations are required when construction is planned to occur on/ near mapped wetlands. The attached plat contains a plat note addressing wetlands. Therefore, staff recommends the removal of this condition.
- 3. Prior to recording of the subdivision plat, the applicant shall remove, or bond for the removal of, the garage shown in Attachment C. Garage has been removed and does not show up on the as-built survey –see Attachment B.
- 4. Prior to construction of the subdivision improvements, the applicant shall submit a detailed drainage management plan consistent with CBJ§49.35.510, including a bioswale. **Completed.**
- 5. Prior to Final Plat Approval, the applicant shall submit a document having the identification, location and elevation of the benchmark used to establish vertical control. The surveyor has identified the elevation mark but not the benchmark used to establish vertical control. The applicant has not been able to reach the surveyor to complete this. The subdivision plat will not be recorded until this condition is met.
- 6. Prior to Final Plat Approval, the applicant shall add the address of the owner in the Plat title block. **Completed see Attachment A.**
- 7. Prior to Final Plat Approval, the applicant shall submit an HOA agreement establishing the maintenance and responsibilities of all common areas, including the driveway. **Completed see Attachment C.**

- 8. Prior to construction, the applicant shall note the contour interval on a topographic plan for Community Development Department acceptance. **Completed.**
- 9. Prior to construction, the applicant shall submit detailed drawings of the proposed utilities and driveway meeting all applicable CBJ Engineering standards. **Completed.**
- 10. Prior to Final Plat approval, the applicant shall designate on the plat a ten foot drainage and no disturbance easement along the entire northeast border of the subdivision. This will allow for a natural filtration of stormwater runoff prior to entering the 18" cross culvert on back loop. **Completed see Attachment A.**
- 11. Prior to construction approval, the applicant shall make a note on the construction drawings stating: The centerline of the driveway shall meander to match the flowline of the ditch to the toe of existing slope. This will maintain the integrity of the existing slope. In addition the ditch shall be widened to 8ft to allow for a bio swale meeting the intention of the CBJ Stormwater Program. **Completed.**

The Land Use Code establishes the permitting process for a Major Subdivision under CBJ 49.15.430 and CBJ 49.15.440 *Final Plat*. This process is shown below.

CBJ 49.15.440 Final plat.

After completion of all conditions and commission acceptance of the preliminary plat in accordance with conditional use permit procedures, the final plat shall be submitted for review and approval according to the following:

(1) Final plat submittal. The final plat may constitute only that portion of the approved preliminary layout which the developer proposes to record and develop at the time of submittal, so long as such portion itself meets the requirements of this title without reference to possible future stages. The final plat shall be prepared by a professional land surveyor, registered in the state, shall be filed with the department and shall meet the survey, monumentation, and certification requirements established by the commission by regulation under Chapter 01.60.

The final subdivision plat is provided under Attachment A.

- (2) Approval procedure.
 - (A) After acceptance of an application and a final plat the director shall schedule the final plat for commission action.

- (B) If commission action on the final plat is scheduled to occur more than 12 months after approval of the preliminary plat, public notice of impending commission action on the final plat may be required.
- (C) The Director shall make a recommendation to the Commission. The recommendation shall include a description of the manner in which all conditions of the preliminary plat have been meet.
- (3) *Commission action*. The Commission shall approve the final plat if the plat substantially conforms to the approved preliminary plat and all applicable conditions have been satisfactorily completed.
- (4) *Notes, restrictions and covenants.* The Commission may place such conditions upon granting of final plat approval as are necessary to preserve the public welfare in accordance with subdivision regulations. When such a condition of approval entails a restriction upon the use of all or part of the property being subdivided, a note specifying such restrictions shall be placed on the face of the plat. Such note shall constitute a restrictive covenant in favor of the municipality and the public, and shall run with the land, enforceable against all subsequent owners. Any such restrictive covenant may be enforced against the subdivider or any subsequent owner by the municipality by injunction or other appropriate action, in the same manner as a permit or permit condition, pursuant to CBJ 49.10.600—660, or by any specifically affected member of the public.

FINDINGS

Except for Condition 5 of the Preliminary Plat permit, all conditions have been met. As stated above, the fulfillment of Condition 5 will be met prior to recording the plat. Staff recommends this as a condition of gaining Final Plat approval.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission adopt the Director's analysis and findings and grant the requested Final Plat permit. The permit would allow for the lot to be subdivided into six new lots. We further recommend that the approval be subject to the following condition:

1) Prior to recording, the applicant shall submit a document having the identification, location and elevation of the benchmark used to establish vertical control.

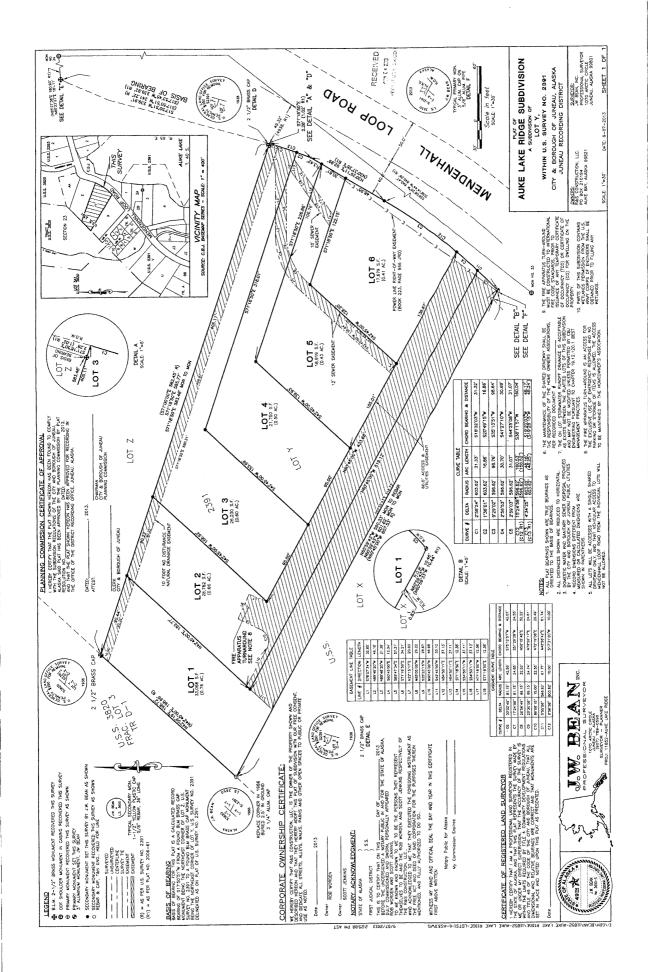

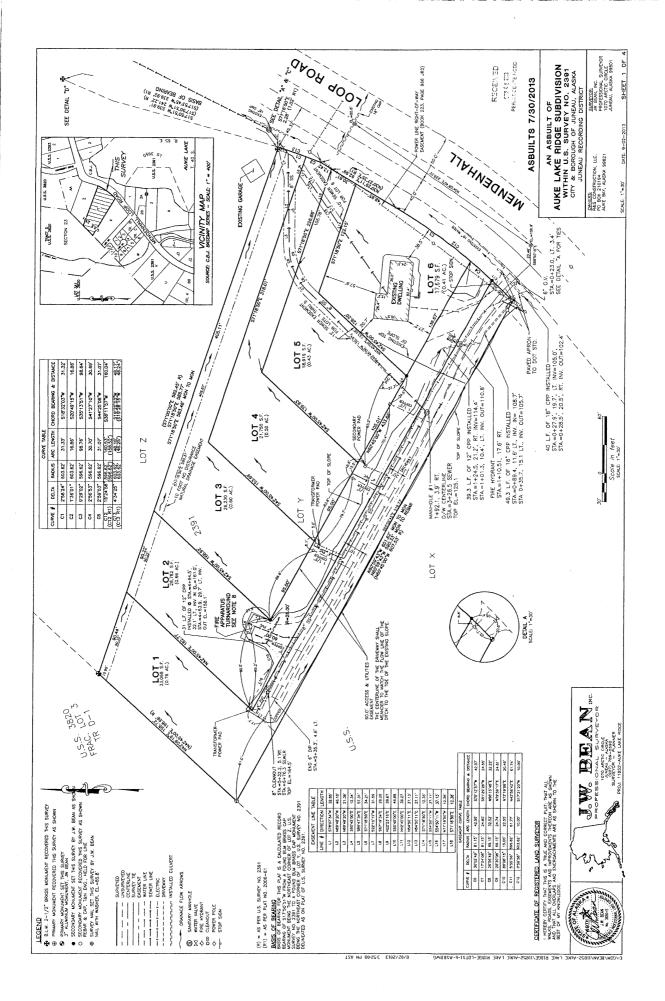

DECLARATION OF AUKE LAKE RIDGE SUBDIVISION PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

WHEREAS, R & S Construction, LLC (hereinafter referred to as Developer) is the owner of that certain real property known as Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision, located in the City and Borough of Juneau, more particularly described in Plat 2013-, Juneau Recording District, First Judicial District, State of Alaska; and

Whereas, the Developer has developed and is selling lots in the Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision and is required to prescribe certain standards regarding the use and occupancy of said lots and common infrastructure; and

Whereas, the purchasers of lots in the Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision have been notified of said covenants and agree to abide by the provisions contained herein;

Now therefore, the Developer declares that all conveyances of the lots in the Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision shall be made and accepted upon the express conditions, provisions, restrictions and covenants of this Declaration which shall apply to and bind the purchasers of the lots, their heirs, successors and assigns. This Declaration is imposed as a general plan for the Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision, and this Declaration is imposed on each and every lot in the subdivision, as follows:

STANDARDS FOR BUILDING ON LOTS

- 1. All lots shall be used for residential purposes. Only one single-family dwelling or duplex is permitted to be constructed on each lot, together with an attached or detached garage or shop. The residence may contain one accessory apartment.
 - 2. No lot may be subdivided.
- 3. The lot purchaser will be required to obtain a CBJ grading permit with a drainage plan prior to receiving a building permit.
 - 4. The Developer will install water and sewer services to each lot.
 - 5. Property owners are responsible for maintenance and repairs to both sewer and water utilities. CBJ Water and Sewer Departments shall retain the right to access both the water valves and sewer cleanouts and manholes. CBJ will not obtain any ownership or responsibility of said utilities. The Fire apparatus turn

around shall be kept clear and maintained by the property owners of the Auke Lake Ridge Subdivision.

HOME OWNER'S ASSOCIATION

- 1. The owners of the lots in the subdivision will form a Home Owner's Association. This association shall assume responsibilities and functions pertaining to the benefit of all lot owners. When the Association is formed, it shall be incorporated as a nonprofit corporation pursuant to AS 10.20 et. seq. Each lot owner shall be a member of the Association.
- 2. The Association shall enact bylaws and regulations for the governance of the Association and the subdivision. Each member lot shall have one vote regarding the affairs of the Association.
- 3. The Association shall assume responsibility for: (a) the maintenance of the fire apparatus turnaround and common road serving all lots to include snow removal; (b) maintain natural drainages and keep the ditches and culverts clean; (c) the enforcement of this Declaration; and (d) such other matters as the Association determines are necessary and desirable to preserve the quality, harmony and value of the subdivision.

ENFORCEMENT, DURATION AND AMENDMENT

- 1. Any lot owner, a group of lot owners, the Developer, and/or the Association, if formed, may enforce this Declaration provided at least twenty (20) days written notice specifying the violation of the Declaration is given to the person(s) or entities claimed to be violating this Declaration. After notice is given, suit may be filed in the Superior Court, First Judicial District, State of Alaska at Juneau to remedy the violation. Alaska law shall govern the interpretation and enforcement of this Declaration. In addition to any other remedy available at law or equity, either or both of the following may be obtained for violation of the Declaration; (a) an injunction to enforce this Declaration, and, (b) due to the difficulty of determining damages, liquidated damages of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per day commencing on the date of the written notice specifying the violation of the Declaration.
- 2. This Declaration shall be in effect with the land indefinitely from the date the Declaration is recorded in the Juneau Recording District, First Judicial District, State of Alaska. Thereafter the Declaration shall automatically extend for successive periods of ten (10) years unless, before the commencement of an automatic extension, an instrument signed by lot owners who own at least sixty percent (60%) of the lots in the subdivision is

recorded in the Juneau Recording District, First Judicial District, State of Alaska terminating this Declaration.

- 3. This Declaration may be amended or modified at any time after three (3) years of it's recording by an instrument containing the amendment or modification signed by lot owners who own at least sixty percent (60%) of the lots in the subdivision. The CBJ shall review all amendments of this declaration.
- 4. Invalidation of any one or more of the provisions of this Declaration shall in no way affect any of the other provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
