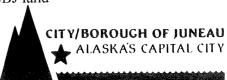

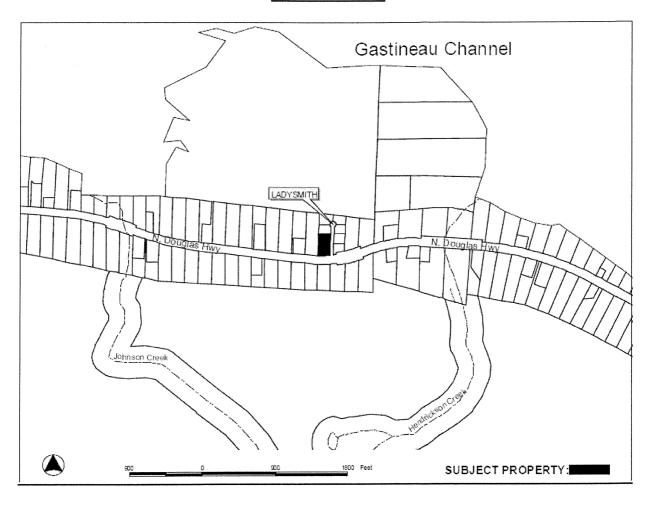

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant requests an Accessory Apartment permit for the development of a 403 square foot accessory apartment to be constructed within the main dwelling unit on the ground floor at 8438 North Douglas Highway (see Attachment C).

The apartment will be a remodel of two bedrooms from a five bedroom bed and breakfast that was operated in the past. The lot also has an on-site wastewater disposal system. The applicant has supplied a letter of approval from ADEC regarding the capacity of the existing wastewater disposal system for the existing five bedroom single-family home. The proposed accessory apartment will be reducing the bedrooms from five to four.

ANALYSIS

Project Site and Design - According to the City and Borough of Juneau's Land Use Code Title 49 section CBJ §49.25.510 (d)(2)(G)(ii), the Accessory Apartment permit requires Planning Commission approval under the Conditional Use Permit process due to the lot not being served by public sewer.

The lot size is 37,461 square feet which exceeds the 36,000 square foot minimum lot size for a lot in the D-1 zone, per the Table of Dimensional Standards, CBJ §49.25.400.

Traffic, Parking, and Circulation - The proposed project has adequate space for parking and meets the parking requirements for a single-family home and accessory apartment. The parking requirements for this property are three parking spaces; two for the single-family home and one for the accessory apartment. Please see Attachment C for proposed parking. The property is served by North Douglas Highway.

Noise - The proposed development will not generate significant noise.

Public Health or Safety - The applicant has provided a Letter of Approval for the on-site wastewater disposal system from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation. Staff is unaware of any other public health or safety issues associated with the proposed development.

Habitat – The project site is located within a mapped wetlands area per the Juneau Wetlands Management Plan. The proposed accessory apartment is an interior remodel of the existing dwelling. The proposed development will not affect onsite habitat.

Property Value or Neighborhood Harmony - No evidence indicates that the proposed development will have a negative impact on property value or neighborhood harmony.

Conformity with Adopted Plans - The project substantially conforms with the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan Policy 4.1 as follows:

Policy 4.1 It is the policy of the CBJ to facilitate the provision and maintenance of safe, sanitary, and affordable housing for its residents.

The proposed development meets the intent of this policy by providing an accessory apartment on a lot with an approved on-site wastewater disposal system.

FINDINGS

CBJ §49.15.330 (e)(1), Review of Director's Determinations, states that the Planning Commission shall review the Director's report to consider:

- 1. Whether the application is complete;
- 2. Whether the proposed use is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses; and,
- 3. Whether the development as proposed will comply with the other requirements of this chapter.

The Commission shall adopt the Director's determination on the three items above unless it finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the Director's determination was in error, and states its reasoning for each finding with particularity.

CBJ §49.15.330 (f), Commission Determinations, states that even if the Commission adopts the Director's determination, it may nonetheless deny or condition the permit if it concludes, based upon its own independent review of the information submitted at the public hearing, that the development will more probably than not:

- 1. Materially endanger the public health or safety;
- 2. Substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area; or,
- 3. Not be in general conformity with the comprehensive plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans.

Per CBJ §49.15.330 (e) & (f), Review of Director's & Commission's Determinations, the Director makes the following findings on the proposed development:

1. Is the application for the requested Accessory Apartment permit complete?

Yes. Staff finds the application contains the information necessary to conduct full review of the proposed operations. The application submittal by the applicant, including the appropriate fees, substantially conforms to the requirements of CBJ Chapter 49.15.

2. Is the proposed use appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses?

Yes. The requested permit is appropriate according to the Table of Permissible Uses. The permit is listed at CBJ §49.25.300, Section 1.130 for the D-1 zoning district.

3. Will the proposed development comply with the other requirements of this chapter?

Yes. The proposed development complies with the other requirements of this chapter. Public notice of this project was provided in the October 11, 2013 and October 21, 2013 issues of the Juneau Empire's "Your Municipality" section, and a Notice of Public Hearing was mailed to all property owners within 500 feet of the subject parcel. Moreover, a Public Notice Sign was posted on the subject parcel, visible from the public Right of Way.

4. Will the proposed development materially endanger the public health or safety?

No. As described in the preceding analysis, available evidence indicates that the proposed development will not materially endanger the public health or safety. The on-site wastewater disposal system has been approved by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.

5. Will the proposed development substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with property in the neighboring area?

No. As described in the preceding analysis, no evidence indicates that the development will substantially decrease the value of or be out of harmony with the property in the neighboring area.

6. Will the proposed development be in general conformity with the land use plan, thoroughfare plan, or other officially adopted plans?

Yes. The proposed development meets the intent of the 2008 Juneau Comprehensive Plan, specifically Policy 4.1, regarding provision of affordable housing.

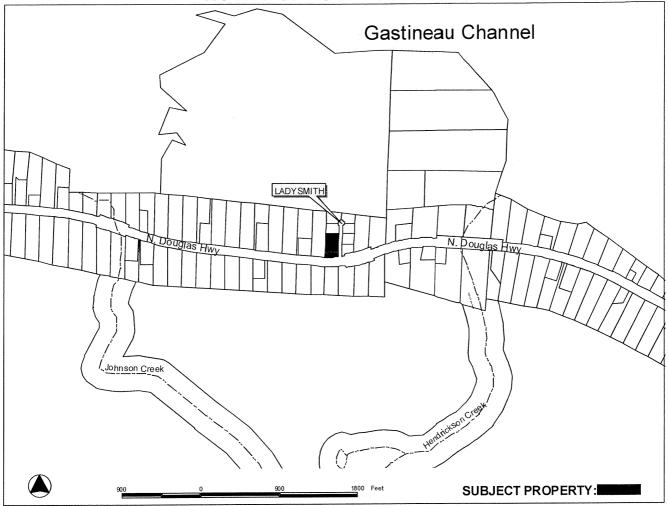
7. Will the proposed development comply with the Juneau Coastal Management Program?

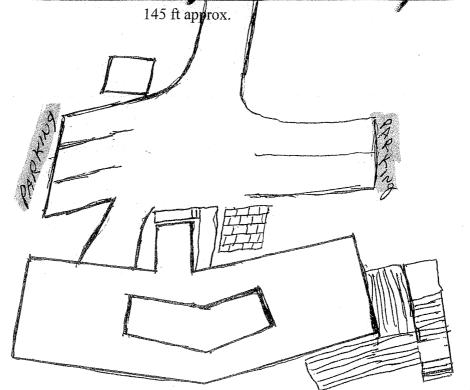

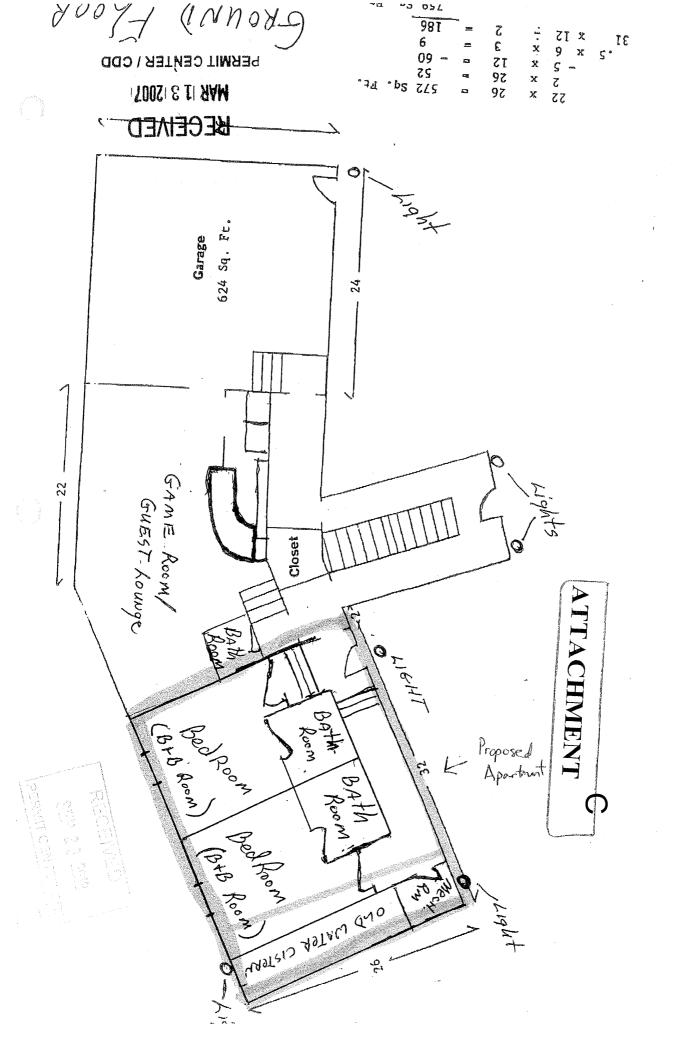

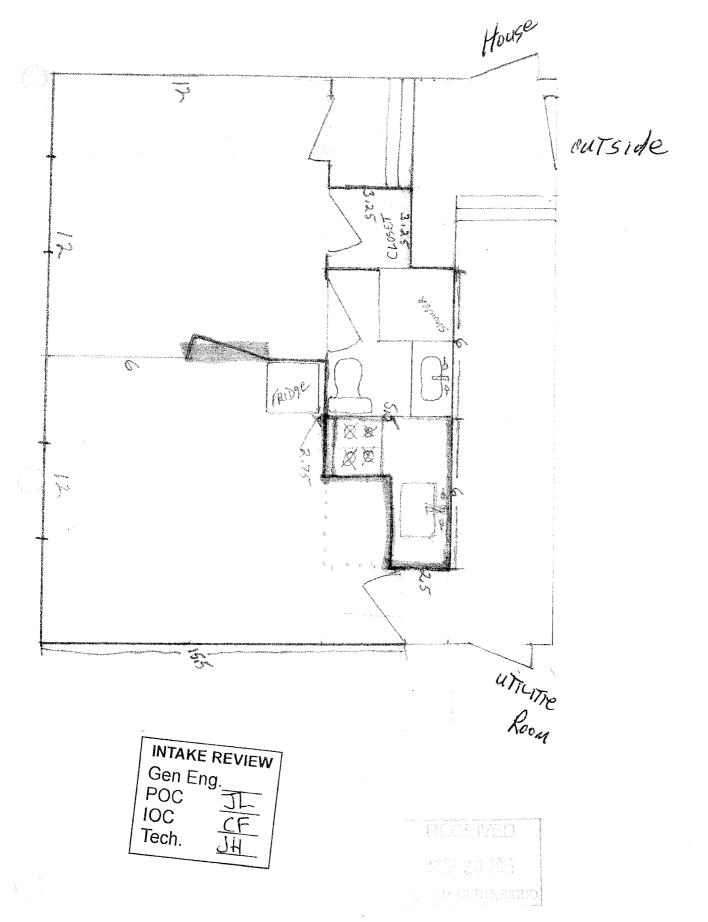

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Haney,

The Department has reviewed the Certification of Construction form and asbuilt information submitted for the domestic wastewater system consisting of a Jet Aeration secondary treatment unit followed by a leachfield of unknown dimension. The treatment and disposal system serves a single-family, five-bedroom home that is used seasonally as a bed and breakfast.

In accordance with 18 AAC 72.240(b) and a maintenance agreement submitted by the property owner on September 11, 2008, **final approval to operate is hereby issued**. The completed construction and operation certificates are attached.

To ensure proper treatment and system operation, the wastewater treatment plant must be maintained according to the manufacturer's recommendations for the life of the system. This may be accomplished by maintaining a service contract with a licensed and manufacturer-approved maintenance provider, or by regular inspections and maintenance performed by other qualified person(s). According to information submitted, the homeowner has committed to performing the needed inspections and will contact local maintenance providers in the event that the system is not functioning properly. The home owner must keep records of all inspections and maintenance on their system.
