The Planning Commission, at the December 10, 2013 regular public meeting, did not adopt the analysis and findings in the attached memorandum dated December 3. The Commission recommended to the Assembly that CSP2013 0026, as described in the project description and drawings submitted with the application, is not in conformance with the Comprehensive Plan. In support of the recommendation, the Planning Commission made the following finding:

1. CSP2013 0026 does not comply with Policy 8.1 in the Comprehensive Plan for the reason that it does not show that it is safer, and it certainly is not more convenient, for the users of our road system.
