The Board of Adjustment, at its regular public meeting, adopted the analysis and findings listed in the attached memorandum dated January 8, 2014, and approved the two Variances to be conducted as described in the project description and project drawings submitted with the application and with the following conditions:

- 1) Prior to the issuance of a Building permit, the applicant shall submit a site plan, and if needed, a narrative, showing/ describing how the snow will be managed on site, including snow from the roof. If snow will be partially managed on adjacent property, the applicant shall submit a recorded easement addressing snow management.
- 2) Prior to the issuance of a Building permit, the applicant shall submit documentation that will ensure the foundation of the parking deck and building will not be eroded by water run-off along both side property lines.
- 3) For the Building permitting process, a surveyor shall verify all yard setbacks for the Foundation Setback Verification Form.
- 4) Prior to Final Certificate of Occupancy, the applicant shall submit an as-built survey showing the parking deck, building and roof eaves all consistent with submitted plans.

Any action by the applicant in reliance on the decision of the Board of Adjustment shall be at the risk that the decision may be reversed on appeal (CBJ §49.20.120).

Effective Date:

The permit is effective upon approval by the Board, January 14, 2014

Expiration Date:

The permit will expire 18 months after the effective date, or July 14, 2015, if no Building Permit has been issued and substantial construction progress has not been made in accordance with the plans for which the development permit was authorized. Application for permit extension must be submitted thirty days prior to the expiration

date.
