The Planning Commission, at a regular public meeting, adopted the analysis and findings listed in the attached memorandum dated July 9, 2014, and made the following additional finding:

1. That the blue folder items provided addressed the Wetlands Review Board's concerns in their entirety.

The Commission found the construction of a separated path from Engineers Cutoff to the Auke Lake Wayside, and construction of a paved parking lot at Auke Lake Wayside consistent with Title 49 and adopted plans therein, and approved the project to be conducted as described in the project description and drawings submitted with the application in accordance with the following conditions:

1. The length of the project shall be signed with wayfinding signs where appropriate as part of the Cross Juneau Bikeway. The applicant must submit a signage and striping plan for review and approval by the Community Development Department for consistency with the Non-Motorized Transportation Plan. (Mandatory)
